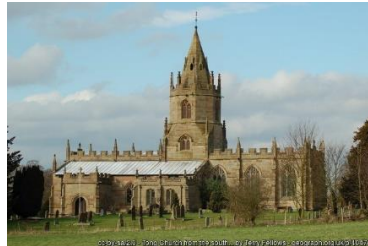
TWO WREKIN GEMS
